DISCLOSEABLE TRANSACTION — FACTORING AGREEMENTS

FACTORING AGREEMENTS WITH FUQIAN

The Board hereby announces that on 8 February 2018 Ruiying Factoring entered into six factoring agreements, being six of the Factoring Agreements with Fuqian, pursuant to which Ruiying Factoring has agreed to provide account receivable factoring service in aggregate principal sum of RMB189,007,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$226,808,400) to Fuqian. In light of the above, as of 8 February 2018, Ruiying Factoring, pursuant to the Factoring Agreements, has agreed to provide account receivable factoring service in aggregate principal sum of not exceeding RMB244,782,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$293,738,400) to Fuqian.

The Directors consider that the Factoring Agreements were entered into on normal commercial terms and in the ordinary and usual course of business of the Group.

LISTING RULES IMPLICATIONS

As one or more of the applicable ratios set out in Rule 14.07 of the Listing Rules in respect of the outstanding principal account receivable factoring service of the Factoring Agreements and the respective transactions contemplated as at 8 February 2018 for the Factoring Agreements are in aggregate more than 5% but are less than 25%, the entering into of the Factoring Agreements and the transactions contemplated therein constitute discloseable transaction(s) for the Company under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules and are therefore subject to the notification and announcement requirements under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules.

I. FACTORING AGREEMENTS

The Board hereby announces that Ruiying Factoring entered into six factoring agreements, being six of the Factoring Agreements, with Fuqian, pursuant to which Ruiying Factoring has agreed to provide account receivable factoring service in aggregate principal sum of RMB189,007,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$226,808,400) to Fuqian. In light of the above, as of 8 February 2018, Ruiying Factoring, pursuant to the Factoring Agreements, has agreed to provide account receivable factoring service in aggregate principal sum of not exceeding RMB244,782,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$293,738,400) to Fuqian.

Each Factoring Agreements contains the similar major terms to each other. The principal terms of the Factoring Agreements are set out as below:

- Dates : 6 September 2017 and six agreements all dated 8 February 2018
- Parties : (1) Fuqian, a company established in the PRC with limited liability and is principally engaged in, among others, import and export of commodities and techniques
- (2) Ruiying Factoring, an indirect non-wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, which principal business is, among other things, the commercial factoring (not in the category of bank facilities), equity interest investment, investment management, finance consultation and corporate management consultation.

To the best knowledge, information and belief of the Directors having made all reasonable enquiries, Fuqian and its ultimate beneficial owners are Independent Third Parties.

Pursuant to the Factoring Agreements, Ruiying Factoring has agreed to provide account receivable factoring service in aggregate principal sum of not exceeding RMB244,782,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$293,738,400) to Fuqian in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Factoring Agreements as of 8 February 2018.

The factoring service shall be provided for period specified in each of the Factoring Agreements. All interest shall be paid at the end of the financing term.

Summary of the credit limit, financing term and interest of each of the Factoring Agreements are as follows:

As of the date of this announcement, the aggregate principal outstanding account receivable factoring service provided by Ruiying Factoring to Fuqian pursuant to the Factoring Agreements does not exceed RMB244,782,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$293,738,400).

Repurchase

In the event that:

- (a) the debtor under the Factoring Agreements (the “**Debtor**”) has still failed to repay the outstanding debt to Ruiying Factoring in full upon the expiry of the financing term and after Ruiying Factoring has demanded the repayment of the outstanding debt;
- (b) prior to the expiry of the financing term, the Debtor notifies Ruiying Factoring or Fuqian in writing the commercial disputes; and/or Ruiying Factoring was acknowledged of the commercial disputes through Fuqian or any other way;

- (c) any one of the following events has occurred to the Debtor:
- (i) the operation condition goes downturn;
 - (ii) the assets and cash are being transferred for the purpose of avoidance of debts;
 - (iii) the commercial reputation is lost; and
 - (iv) the ability to repay the debts has been or is likely to be lost,

Ruiying Factoring shall have the right to request Fuqian to repurchase the account receivable due by the Debtor and repay all the outstanding sum due, including the interest, to Ruiying Factoring.

II. REASONS FOR THE FACTORING AGREEMENTS

The Group is principally engaged in road and bridge construction business, agricultural and petrochemical products supply chain services business, and agricultural industry chain financial services business and agricultural big data services business. The Directors consider that the Factoring Agreements were entered into on normal commercial terms and in the ordinary and usual course of business of the Group.

Given that the Factoring Agreements are being conducted in the ordinary and usual course of business of Ruiying Factoring, which will earn a considerable profit over the respective financing term, and are under normal commercial terms, the Directors are of the view that the terms of the Factoring Agreements, including the credit limits under the Factoring Agreements, are fair and reasonable and are in the interests of the Company and Shareholders as a whole.

III. LISTING RULES IMPLICATION

The applicable ratios set out in Rule 14.07 of the Listing Rules in respect of the outstanding principal account receivable factoring service of the Factoring Agreements and the respective transactions contemplated prior to 8 February 2018 for the Factoring Agreements are in aggregate *not* more than 5% and thus the transactions contemplated therein do not constitute a discloseable transaction for the Company under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules and are therefore not subject to the notification and announcement requirements under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules.

As at 8 February 2018, one or more of the applicable ratios set out in Rule 14.07 of the Listing Rules in respect of the outstanding principal account receivable factoring service of the Factoring Agreements and the respective transactions contemplated are in aggregate more than 5% but are less than 25%, the entering into of each of the Factoring Agreements and the transactions contemplated therein now constitute a discloseable transaction for the Company under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules and are therefore subject to the notification and announcement requirements under Chapter 14 of the Listing Rules.
